Bruckner's hastily-written manuscript leaves a number of details open; for example, the distribution of the text is not always clear (there are sometimes too many or too few notes in a measure). The slurs joining notes to syllables, elsewhere carefully notated by Bruckner, are missing, as is the second verse; the text is written only below the bass, and the dynamics are only notated for the soprano. This has been silently corrected. The organ realization derives from a copy made for August Göllerich (1859–1923) by the copyist "JH", Austrian National Library, Vienna (A-Wn) *Mus. Hs.* 19718. Parts of it correspond to earlier variants of the autograph. The organ part has therefore been adjusted in a few passages to match the valid variants. The musically coherent re-entry of the accompaniment in m. 13 remains unchanged, despite the figured bass written already in m. 12. The slurs joining notes to syllables that are also found in the organ part have not been included.
